

NINTH ANNUAL CCS CONFERENCE ATTRACTS MORE THAN 850

The Eighth Annual Carbon Capture and Sequestration Conference, sponsored by *ExchangeMonitor Publications & Forums* in partnership with the National Energy Technology Laboratory, attracted a record crowd of more than 850 participants, representing some 21 countries to Pittsburgh.
