

TENTH ANNUAL CCS CONFERENCE ATTRACTS 700

The Tenth Annual Carbon Capture and Sequestration Conference, sponsored by *ExchangeMonitor Publications & Forums* in partnership with the National Energy Technology Laboratory, attracted a crowd of 700 participants to Pittsburgh last week. Led by keynote speakers including NETL Director Anthony Cugini, American Electric Power Chairman and CEO Michael Morris, Director of Natural Resources Defense Council's Climate Center David Hawkins and West Virginia Public Service Commissioner Jon McKinney, the conference probed a wide range of issues facing the CCS community, from regulatory and technical issues to public acceptance and government funding.
